Parking: Please drop athletes off at the high school entrance on Route 370. Buses may exit the traffic circle and reenter the HS and park in the back lot that is to the right of the HS. Additional parking is available further up the road in the middle school and elementary lots. Please do not park buses in front of the high school or in the fire lanes. The parking lot next to baseball fields on 370 will be reserved for spectator parking.

Driving directions

From the East: Driving from the Thruway, I-90, take Exit #39 for State Hwy 690 North toward Fulton merge onto Route 690W and go 5.5 miles. Take the Route 31E/Route 370W exit toward Baldwinsville for .3 miles. Turn RIGHT and travel West on Route 370 for 11 miles. The High School building is

located on the right, continue on .5 mile for the Elementary and Middle School buildings also on the right.

From the West: Driving from the Thruway, I-90, take Exit #40 for Route 34 toward Weedsport. Turn left onto Route 34 North and proceed for 8 miles. After entering the village of Cato, turn RIGHT onto Route 370/East Main St. Continue to follow Route 370 for 1.2 miles, the Elementary and Middle School buildings will be on the left, continue on for .5 mile to the High School building also on the left.

From the South: Driving from Auburn, take Route 34 North for approximately 17 miles. After entering the village of Cato, turn RIGHT onto Route 370/East Main St. Continue to follow Route 370 for 1.2 miles, the Elementary and Middle School buildings will be on the left, continue on .5 mile to the High School building also on the left.

From the North: Driving from Oswego, take Route 104 West for approximately 12.5 miles. Turn LEFT onto Route 34 and drive approximately 9.6 miles. After entering the village of Cato, turn LEFT onto Route 370/East Main St. Continue to follow Route 370 for 1.2 miles, the Elementary and Middle School buildings will be on the left, continue on for .5 mile to the High School building also on the left.
