<u>Location</u>: Como Lake Park - Lancaster, New York (13 miles East of Buffalo)

<u>From the Northtowns</u>: Interstate 90 West, to Exit 52A (William St.), turn left onto William St., turn right onto Union Rd., quick left onto Losson Rd, continue on Losson Rd until you cross over Transit Rd, once over Transit Rd. Losson Rd. changes back into William St., continue on William St. for approximately 2.5 miles, turn left into Como Park.

<u>From the Southtowns</u>: Interstate 90 East, to Exit 52A (William St.), turn right onto William St., turn right onto Union Rd., quick left onto Losson Rd, continue on Losson Rd until you cross over Transit Rd, once over Transit Rd. Losson Rd. changes back into William St., continue on William St. for approximately 2.5 miles, turn left into Como Park.

Course Description:

This is a 3.1 mile / 5 km race, it is flat, has some Rolling Hills and one steep upgrade. The course is mostly grass with pavement Crossings.

Parking:

Near the main Lodge in Como Park called the Casino. There is plenty of parking in front of and behind this building.
